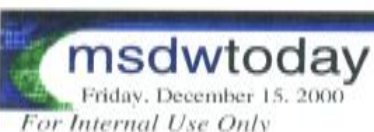

## MSDW's Michael Davidson Runs Athens Marathon

On November 5, 2000 Michael Davidson of Corporate Services completed the Athens Marathon and in the process raised over \$20,000 for the Epilepsy Foundation of New York City. The 26.2-mile race commemorates the run of the soldier Pheidippides from a battlefield at the site of the town of Marathon, Greece to Athens in 490 B.C., bringing news of a Greek victory over the Persians. When the modern Olympic Games were inaugurated in 1896 in Greece, the legend of Pheidippides was revived by a run from Marathon Bridge to Olympic Stadium in Athens, the current course of the Athens Marathon.

Michael's cause hits close to home. His mother, Cathleen, was diagnosed with epilepsy at the age of 12. Epilepsy is a chronic, unpredictable neurological disorder that briefly interrupts the normal electrical activity of the brain. The mission of the Epilepsy Foundation of New York City is to help individuals and families affected by epilepsy achieve their highest level of physical, emotional and social well-being.
